Key Vocabulary

Frame	The strong skeleton that holds something together, like the bones that hold your body up.
Tension	A pulling force that stretches something, like when you pull both ends of an elastic band.
Structure	Something made by putting parts together so it can stand up and do a job, like a bridge or building.
Stability	How well something stays standing without wobbling, falling, or tipping over.
Joint	A place where two or more parts are connected together.
Shelter	A safe place that protects you from weather like rain, wind, or sun.
Durability	How long something lasts and how well it resists damage, wear, or breaking.
Rigid	Very stiff and not easy to bend.
Covering	Something that goes over or around something else to protect or hide it.
