## Key Vocabulary

<b>Applique</b>	Decorating fabric by sewing a piece of fabric shape onto another piece, like sewing a star onto a bag.
<b>Blanket stitch</b>	A type of sewing stitch that goes along the edge of fabric to stop it fraying and to decorate it.
<b>Reinforce</b>	Making something stronger so it doesn't break or tear easily, like adding extra stitches to a seam.
<b>Back stitch</b>	Individual stitches that are made backward to the general direction of sewing.
<b>Decorate</b>	To add details to a design to improve its appearance.
<b>Seam</b>	Where two edges of material are joined or sewn together.
<b>Template</b>	A shape that you can draw around.
<b>Prototype</b>	A prototype is an early version of a product that designers make.
