<p>Do you enjoy lessons in Year 3? Tell me why.</p> <p>What are the key expectations set by adults in your class around attitudes to learning and your work?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – I like Year 3 and school because we do lots of sports and learn new things in class. Miss Lee expects us to be quiet and sensible in the room and to sit smartly. – Learning is super fun in school to learn and we do lots of different sports in PE with Mr Pope. We are expected to show our value of “Respect” in class by being quiet. – PE sometimes changes my bad days into good days. We also learn and make things in lessons. We are expected to show kindness and do the right thing “first time” when in class.
<p>How does school keep you and children safe and around expectations around school?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – Around school we have lots of pictures showing us what we should show in class and around school. We are also not left alone in class or in school. – We sometimes do assemblies when we learn new things to be safe in school and at home. – We do fire drills in school to practice what to do when the alarm goes off. There is a new sign on the playground which shows where we line up.
<p>In Science you have been covering Health and Nutrition. Can you talk me through what you have learnt? <i>(In Science we have been learning about Health and Nutrition. Did you know?)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – In Science we have been learning about being healthy. Did you know protein helps our muscles repair and it comes from meats and fish? – In Science we have been learning about being healthy. Did you know fats and oils can be good for us as they give us little bits of energy? – In Science we have been learning about being healthy. Did you know when a plant was dehydrated it absorbs the water quickly because it needs it? This is like when we need water to drink.
<p>In Geography you have been learning about the UK. Can you talk me through what you have learnt? <i>(In Geography we have been learning about the UK. Did you know?)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – In Geography we have been learning about the UK. Did you know that Edinburgh is the capital of Scotland? (then started explaining London, Cardiff and Belfast as the other capitals). – In Geography we have been learning about the UK. Did you know that rural areas are like the countryside and urban are towns? There are more rural spaces in the UK. – In Geography we have been learning about the UK. Did you know there are rivers that are safe to swim and some that aren’t? There’s the River Thames in London (SS added that Calder is the river through Burnley)
<p>Think of a topic you have covered in Maths during Year 3. Can you share what you have learnt? <i>(In Maths we have been learning about Did you know?)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> – In Maths we have been learning about the subtracting 3-digit numbers when exchanging. Did you know if the higher number is smaller than the bottom number we exchange from the next number? (Solved $341 - 119 = 222$) – In Maths we have been learning about times tables. Did you know $12 \times 4 = 48$? I know that by practicing counting in 4s. – In Maths we have been learning about the subtracting with column method. Did you know we have to exchange from the next number if there is a 0 in the hundreds? (Solved $607 - 239 = 368$ with support but then solved $303 - 146 = 157$ independently)
