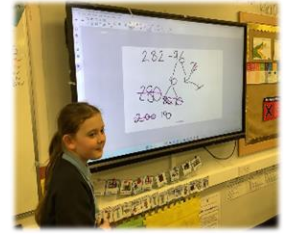
### Another Busy Week of Sporting Events!
