Yr4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC)

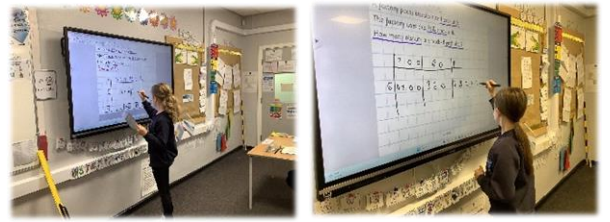
