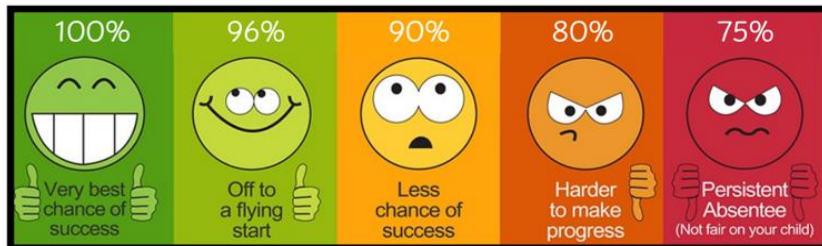


Curriculum In Action: Music – Lancashire Sings (Choir)
